Empty Container Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in our Empty Container Recycling Services. We recycle and/or dispose of plastic and steel containers ranging in sizes from 5-gal to 600-gal. In order for us to provide you a customized Recycling Program, we need to obtain information from you about your containers. Please complete as much information as possible on the **Empty Container Recycling Services Information Form**. We may require Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) if we are not familiar with the prior contents you have listed. We will ask you for this information on an as-needed basis.

Regulatory agencies have indicated that the drum emptier and the drum recycler are "jointly and severally" liable for the handling of empty drum residues. Therefore, for your and our protection, all wastes generated by our recycling process are incinerated, at very high cost, by EPA compliant disposal facilities. This practice requires that all drums be completely empty. COMPLETELY EMPTY means: free-flowing residues have been completely poured-out; viscous residues that cling to the interior surface have been scraped out, exposing 90% of the drum's original surface.

The Empty Container Certification accompanies each shipment (see sample). Please note that the D.O.T. requires that all original labels must remain on the drums and all closure devices must be in place and securely fastened prior to shipment. Drums must be shipped loose, stacked right-side-up without skids.

Our Recycling Services are most economical when we receive sufficient advance information. Please include as much detail as possible on the enclosed form. The completion of our Services includes a performance certification for your records.
